# What Should Happen Here - Today? (June 24, 2018, at WBC) Isaiah 6:1-9a (KJV)

Uzziah died in 742BC. Ruled 52 years - started at age 16

Why are you here? Friends, songs, Prayers, Preaching – all good things Five things to help understand Worship.

- I. CONNECTION 6:1a I saw the Lord For worship to take place We see the Lord
  - A. The Means to assist our worship
    - Prayers to God
    - Praise to God
    - Preach about God

When we connect with God and we worship, we recognize that He is holy - "Holy, Holy, Holy"

- B. A Word of Caution
- C. The Nature of the God we worship
- II. CONVICTION 6:5a takes place when we meet God
  - A. Connection with God always leads to Conviction by God
  - B. We only connect with the living God, we confront an unerring Paradox:
- The closer we come to God, the farther away from God we realize ourselves to be.
- The farther away from God we get, the less aware we are of the distance/chasm between God and us.

#### III. CONFESSIONS - 6:5b

Two choices we face in responding to conviction

- A. To Cover Our Sin Proverbs 28:13a He who covers his sin will not prosper. We can't hide from God.
- B. To Confess Our Sin Proverbs 28:13b We should confess our sin to have worship. We can be clean before a Holy God

## IV. CLEANSING - 6:7

- A. Our Part Confessing
- B. God's Part Cleansing

#### I JOHN 1:7, 9

- 1:7b The blood of Jesus Christ, his Son, cleanseth us from all sin
- 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

## V. CONSECRATION / COMMITMENT - 6:8c - Here I am, send me

- A. The ultimate and practical outcome of the above 4 dimensions is Commitment to the God we worship.
- B. Inevitable this leads to OUTREACH to a world lost and without God.
