"To judge" - krino - to separate, to choose, pronounce judgment, in this context it means to assume the office of the judge. *In this passage,* Jesus condemns a critical spirit, which judges others from a manmade, misguided standard.

Two Guideposts for Godly Living:

- I. Right principles (verses 1-2, 6)
 - A. You should not live with a disparaging, judgmental spirit.
 - 1. an erroneous view of God
 - 2. an erroneous view of others
 - 3. an erroneous view of self
 - B. You should live with a discerning, judicious spirit. (John 7:24; 1 Corinthians 2:15; 1 John 4:1)

Such a discerning, judicial spirit is necessary because:

- 1. it recognizes false teaching
- 2. it recognizes false professors
- 3. it recognizes fruitless lives
- **II. Right patterns** (verses 3-5) (James 1:23-24, 25, 1 John 4:1, Luke 6:36-37)
 - A. Recognize your own sin
 - B. Repent of your sin
 - C. Restore the sinful brother or sister in Christ
