When It's Wrong to Do Good Luke 10:38-42 (KJV)

Introduction:

- (1) Is it ever wrong to do good?
- (2) Our text suggests there are at least **four** times when it is wrong to do good.

I. When We Do the Right Thing in the Wrong Spirit

- Nothing wrong with what Martha did (Practical, Thoughtful).
- She lost her perspective.

II. When We Conclude That Doing Good Alone "Makes Us Spiritual"

- Made Martha argumentative with Jesus and accusative of her sister.
- Look at the Pharisees.

III. When the Good We Do Becomes the Norm/Standard for the Good Everyone Else Must Do

- When we try to "play God" for other people.
- When we try to make everyone fit our mold of "what is good."

IV. When Doing Good Diverts Us From Doing the Best

- The greatest enemy to "the best" is usually not "the bad," but "the good."
- Doing "the best" is a **choice**—not zapped to us by the horoscope!
- Goodness without Christ is the worst kind of badness.
